UPGRADE NOTICE

Will Builder Version 16.2C is now available for upgrade. This release includes the new sophisticated user interface, designed to help improve your workflow and create a consistent look and feel across all Do Process products. Note the following major enhancements:

- We have added a **Login** screen that contains links to valuable resources.
- There is a **Home** page that provides access to Will Builder features and a quick way to create new records or search for and open existing records.
- The redesigned Parties topic makes it easier to indicate each party's role in a Will or POA (Executor, Beneficiary, Guardian, Attorney).
- A redesigned **Dispositions** topic simplifies the addition and view of dispositions.
- New components surround each topic to provide access to record-related features.
- A Tools page replaces the main toolbar and provides access to commonly used features and modules.
- A Configuration page provides a quick way for the Default user to access frequently used configurable features.

Renaming the Upgrade File

If you are upgrading Will Builder from Version 16.2, you will need to rename the **UPGRADE.EXE** file in the Will Builder program directory if the file **DPS_UPGR.EXE** does not exist. Follow these steps to ensure a successful upgrade:

STEP 1: Locate the Will Builder program directory (e.g. **C:\WILLBUILDER** for standalone installations or on the server for a network installation).

How do I find the program directory?

- i. Launch Will Builder.
- ii. Click Help > About > Info.
- iii. In the **System Info** screen, click **Explorer.**
- iii. Click 1. Program Directory in the popup box.

The program directory opens in a separate window.






- STEP 2: In the right panel of the program directory window, use the vertical scrollbar to locate the **UPGRADE.EXE** file.
- STEP 3: Rename the file to **DPS_UPGR.EXE**.

How do I rename the file?

- i. Right-click the **UPGRADE.EXE** filename.
- ii. Choose **Rename** in the popup box.A box surrounds the highlighted file name.



iv. Type DPS_UPGR.EXE and press Enter.

How Do You Upgrade?

All users must log out of Will Builder during the upgrade. Then the Default users goes to **Configuration > Live Upgrade > [Check for Update]** and follows the installation directions.
